

All you need to know about...

BT Blanking Tape

Reference: BT10/16R (to suit 10mm or 16mm sheet)

BT25R (to suit 25mm sheet)

Size: BT10/16R - 38mm wide x 50 metres long

BT25R - 50mm wide x 50 metres long

Description:

A metallised polypropylene supplied in rolls to suit the appropriate thickness of multiwall polycarbonate.

How it works:

When cutting multiwall polycarbonate, dirt, dust and swarf will become lodged in the open flutes of the product. These flutes should have air blown through them to dislodge the dirt, dust and swarf to make the sheet clean and presentable. The blanking tape is then applied over the open flutes at the ridge (upper) end of the sheet.

The flutes at the <u>eaves (lower) end</u> of the sheet are taped over with the ADT anti-dust breather tape.

As standard when supplying cut panels of multiwall polycarbonate, Twinfix will blow the flutes free of dirt, dust and swarf and apply BT blanking tape and ADT anti-dust tape so panels are actually supplied ready to fit.

Applications:

 Covers and protects the flutes on the ridge end of multiwall polycarbonate
