Spanning an impressive 61 square metres, this striking structure provides a sheltered outdoor dining area for staff and visitors—a perfect blend of form and function.

To complement the sleek, contemporary design of the new canteen, we constructed the canopy with a durable aluminium frame finished in anthracite grey (RAL 7016), chosen for its modern, understated aesthetic. At the heart of the canopy is our innovative Multi-Link-Panel Non-Fragile System, a high-performance roof glazing solution. This system is not only lightweight but also offers exceptional durability, weather resistance, and low-maintenance upkeep—making it ideal for busy environments.

Year-Round Usability
